I went to the location and saw the monument being moved and the badges and bolts to secure the top part of the monument were broken. I don't know when the monument was vandalized violently like that, but today on Jan 18, 2019 it is still there. I reported the vandalism to the SJPD last night.

I hope that SJ city could help us or at least find out ways to make this residential and business area be safe and well-lit to avoid some criminal activities at night and the vandalism and the graffiti to the monument that have occurred a few times recently.

As for the damaged monument, we plan to replace it with a new one and bring this damaged back to the community to repair. So, we need the city to provide safety when we install the new monument.
